### TUITION REFUNDS ARE PROCESSED AS FOLLOWS::

**A 100% REFUND CAN BE MADE TO A STUDENT WHO WITHDRAWS BY REGISTRATION DAY (January 5, 2010).** A 75% REFUND CAN BE MADE TO A STUDENT WHO WITHDRAWS BEFORE THE 10% POINT IN THE SEMESTER. The 75% refund begins on the first day of class, January 6, 2010 and ends on Last Day for Tuition Refund, January 20, 2010.

**NO REFUND WILL BE ISSUED AFTER January 21, 2010.**
