
HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUNDS II (HEERF II)

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II), commonly referred to as the CARES Act, is authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260, signed into law on Dec. 27, 2020. In total, the CRRSAA authorizes \$81.88 billion in support for education through the Coronavirus Aid, Recovery, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Public Law 116-136.

Under CRRSAA, MTCC received an allocation of \$263,988 to be awarded directly to students in the form of emergency grants to assist with expenses associated with the COVID-19 pandemic, including (but not limited to) food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare, and child care. There is no application for the HEERF II CARES Act Emergency Grant. Students will automatically be awarded the emergency funds based on the following criteria and will receive an email notification through their MTCC email accounts.

- 2020-2021 FAFSA on file
- Satisfactory Academic Progress
- Enrollment Status (FT, QT, HT, or LTHT)
- TIV Eligible Program of Study

These emergency grants are NOT considered to be financial aid or a loan. Students will NOT be required to repay these funds. Receipt of an emergency grant will have no effect on future financial aid eligibility.

Award amounts for the 2021 spring semester will vary depending on the individual student's FAFSA EFC:
